





GASMEMS (Gas Flows in Micro Electro Mechanical Systems) is a project dedicated to the research on gases in microstructures. A network of 13 participants and 6 associated partners coming from all over the European Community provides fundamental and applied research in the fields of dynamics of gas micro flows and of microstructure design and manufacturing as well as applications in lab and industry. The GASMEMS project of the European Community presents its second combined International Workshop and Summer School, taking place at the Helios Hotel, Les Embiez Island, France. The island is located between Marseille (80 km) and Toulon (50 km).

Scientific program

The workshop and summer schools programs will cover the following topics:

- Dynamics of gas micro flows
- Heat and mass transfer in gas micro flows
- Gas materials interactions

In each of these fields, new developments will be presented, concerning:

- Modelling and simulation tools
- Materials and manufacturing techniques
- Experimental techniques and measurements

Within the 2nd International Workshop a variety of talks will be selected to present a state-of-the art view to the covered topics as well as new developments and research results. A poster session is dedicated to round the workshop thematically. The program will include keynote lectures, invited lectures and contributed papers. The number of contributions is limited.









The 2nd International GASMEMS Summer School will present lectures from fundamental knowledge to advanced level. Topical talks of highly experienced and skilled specialists from universities, research labs and industry will provide deep view inside the topics of the GASMEMS project.

Conference and accommodation fees

3-day Summer School Fee: € 650,- (incl. 3 nights)
2-day Workshop fee: € 450,- (incl. 2 nights)
Combined ticket (SS & WS): € 1100,- (incl. 6 nights)

Fees include the participation costs to the events + double room accommodation (shared with another participant) + meals + boat ticket.

An extra night will be charged €100.

A single room option will be charged €30 per night.

Contributed papers

Contributed papers for the workshop will be accepted as oral or poster presentations. Participants who wish to present a paper are requested to submit a full paper manuscript in PDF format (short paper, 8 pages A4 maximum) for peer review. A template will be available at the GASMEMS website. The full papers will be published on CD-ROM.

All draft papers will have to be submitted before March 20, 2010 using the paper submission site, available from the GASMEMS website: www.gasmems.eu.
